

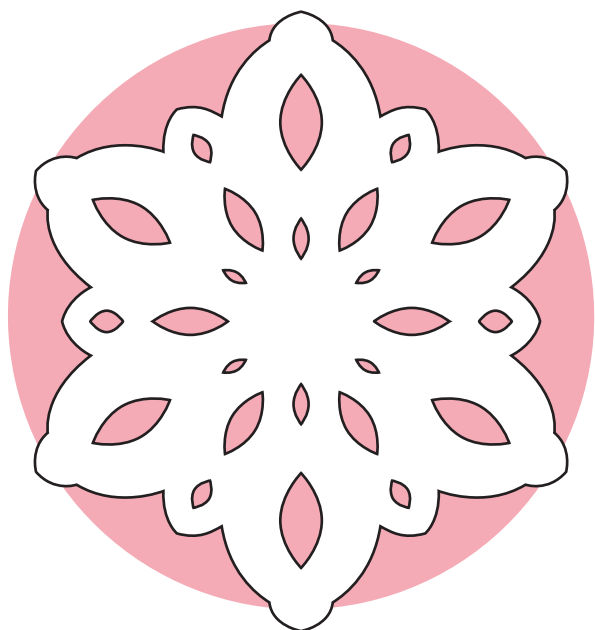


Paper Snowflakes!

kids only!
**ACTIVITY
CORNER**

you will need...

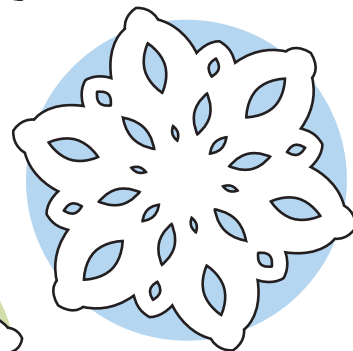
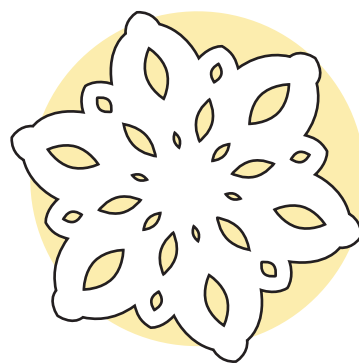
White paper
Coloured tissue paper
A mug or a small plate
Pencil
Glue stick
Scissors – watch your fingers!
Glitter – if you want to
make them sparkle.



follow these easy steps...

one:

Lay your piece of white paper on a flat surface, and place your mug or small plate on top. Draw round the circle, and then carefully cut it out. Now do the same thing with your tissue paper.

Paper Snowflakes!

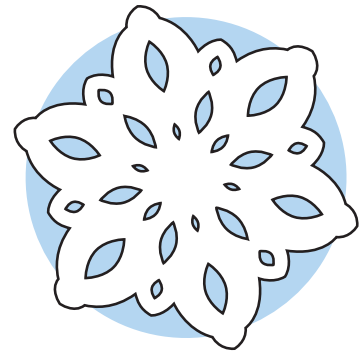
two:

Fold the white circle in half, then fold into three by folding the right side in just over half way, and then the left. Cut out shapes (triangles and circles work best) from both sides. We used this pattern to get the snowflake shown, but you can cut it any way you want to make lots of different types!



three:

Unfold the paper – do this very carefully so you don't rip it. Then, put little dots of glue all over one side, and stick it down on to your tissue paper circle.



You can make all kinds of different snowflakes, and you can draw around different plates to make bigger ones if you wish. When you have made a few, you could glue the backs onto a ribbon to make a snowflake chain.
